

1. Title of the Practice:

Community Service through blood Donation camp.

Objective of the practice:

The objective of the practice is to serve the community and inculcate the values of social service among all stakeholders by organizing blood donation camps in the college.

The context:

Mere presence of the students and other stakeholders in the programs and events organised by the college falls short in order to inculcate a sense of community service among them. The college emphasizes on the engagement between academic program and community services so that all the stakeholders can forge linkage between theory and practice, and knowledge and action.

The Practice:

Annasaheb Gundewar college run by Village Uplift Society organizes blood donation camp every year on 10th of January to celebrate the birth anniversary of Dadasaheb Kannamwar, the founder President of the Society. The college intends to extend cooperation and help those who need blood. The college organizes the camp in collaboration with Blood Bank. In the academic session 2020-2021, the college organized the event in collaboration with GSK Blood Bank, Ramdaspath, Nagpur.

Evidence of success:

The practice has made a positive impact on all stakeholders. The impact is also seen on personality development, moral sense and on civic responsibility and the sense of discipline and enhanced sense of community service among the regular students and other stakeholders towards the society. The students could also learn managerial ability through the event.

Problems encountered and Resources required:

Due to Covid19 -Pandemic, the students and alumni could not turn up in numbers, as we expected.

2. Title of the Practice

College Student Responsibility Fund.

Objectives of the Practice

The practice aims to help students with respect to admission and examination fees, participation in conference, workshop, paper presentation, patent registration fees etc.

Context

Education is the only level of many disparities. But right help at the right time will bridge the gaps by helping poor and needy students with monetary support.

Practice:

R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur vide its letter dt. 3/10/2020 directed all the affiliated colleges to raise College Student Responsibility Fund, aiming to develop all-round personality of students. The Student Development Cell, constituted in the college, called for a meeting and informed and sought the consent of the staff for a monthly voluntary contribution of Rs. 100/ from the salary to help poor, needy and eligible students. Total Rs.41050/ deposited in the account.

Evidence of success:

Due to Covid 19- Pandemic, the students could not attend the college physically. But the fund collected in the academic session 2020-2021, is being utilized in the academic session 2021-2022 with respect to admission, exam fees, research, sports and games and patient registration. Our student, Mayuri Surendra Patle of B.A. First Year was given financial help of Rs.26,050/- to bear medical expenses as she hails from an economically poor background.

In order to extend financial help to the students, we need more individuals and philanthropists and institutions to come forward to help students on a larger scale
